

WEST READING SWIMMING POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS 2018

It is the responsibility of all pool patrons to read, understand, and follow all West Reading Swimming Pool Regulations. Failure to do so may result in membership privileges being revoked and/or suspension from the facility.

Registration Information

Membership forms are available at Borough Hall. Submit your form at Borough Hall by May 25th 2018. After that date, present your registration form to the front desk at the pool. Patrons using credit cards must pay at Borough Hall. All membership photos must be taken at the pool on/after May 26th. Only those 18 years and older will be permitted to complete and sign a season registration form.

Pool Rules and responsibility for Person Accompanying Child under 12

YOU MUST:

1. Be a season member of the pool, or pay the daily swimmer rate, or pay the daily spectator rate.
2. Avoid distractions when supervising children near water (e.g., phones, laptop, and books, etc).
3. Be within arms' reach of child using swimming aids.
4. Keep children under constant supervision when they are in the wading pool.
5. Recognize that lifeguards are not there to babysit your children.
6. If a child is missing, check the pool first. Seconds count.

POOL RULES: **All rules are intended as a summary and are subject to change.**

- Always obey pool personal.
- Patrons/off duty staff: Do not socialize with lifeguards while on duty.
- Pool staff and management determine what floatation devices and toys are appropriate.
- Only use ramps for one purpose: to enter and exit the pool.
- Stay off the ropes. They are not floatation devices.
- Do not engage in horseplay: includes dunking, running, pushing, chicken, and noodle fights.
- No food or drink near water.
- No smoking/e-cigarettes or tobacco products of any kind within the pool property.
- No open lewdness or profanity – this is a family facility.
- No glass containers.
- **No Alcohol**
- No outside food, of any kind, for parties unless approved by the Recreation Director.
- No cooler larger than a 6 can capacity.
- Do not enter the pool if you have open wounds or infectious sores.
- Promptly dispose of all trash and recyclable items.
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Lock all bicycles on bike rack outside the pool gate.
- No diapers are permitted in the pool. (Swim diapers are available at the desk.)
- **Swimsuits are required for all patrons.**
NO clothing allowed in pool – (t-shirt, shorts, tank tops, underwear, and bra). First offence is a warning. Second offence: you will be asked to leave and you will no longer be allowed in the pool for the rest of the season. This goes for members and non-members!!!!

Sliding Board Use

Please be advised that all swimmers, ages 17 and under unless otherwise noted, must pass a swimming test administered by swimming pool management and/or lifeguards in order to use the sliding board. Wristbands will be issued in lieu of patches. If you have any questions regarding this policy, please contact Recreation Director at 610.374.8273. Thank you

Pool Parties Obtain a complete set of Rules and Regulations for pool parties when making your reservations. Reservations must be made with the Recreation Director at least ten days in advance for pool parties consisting of more than 6 people. Requests for private pool parties after normal hours must be submitted to the Recreation Director at Borough Hall at least two weeks in advance.
